Understanding more about termites



The danger of subterranean termites is they rarely come to the surface to feed.

Unlike any other common pests, subterranean termites are a lot more challenging to identify and manage, and the danger they pose is they rarely come to the surface to feed. Very often, termites are mistaken for ants and less guarded against, or their infestation discovered only when it is too late.

Termites can enter cracks, invade ceilings, windows, door frames and panels, and can consume beyond timber, attacking any cellulose materials and may cause damage to electrical wiring and conduits. Damages can be caused both architecturally and financially. For instance, the weakening of structural strength and financial implications resulting from damaged flooring, wall or furniture.

You might be experiencing subterranean **termite infestation** if these scenarios look familiar.



Mud shelter tubes, which subterranean termites build out of mud, faecal matter and saliva, so that they can move above ground to search for food.




Swarms or discarded termite wings found on window sills or floors.



Damaged or eaten wood, or wood with mud tubes, which indicates the presence of termites.


